

Master Plan Purpose

- Create Facility Master Plan
 - Sync facility funding to needs; fulfill the intention of the grants
 - Create a sequencing for future improvements
 - Obtain DRPT approval to proceed
- Current and future improvements to be derived from the master plan.
- Master Plan is contained in a full report

Review parking lot needs; integrate grants

- Parking lot
 - Organization of lot per 2022 SRF study (including assigned vehicle parking)
 - Pavement rehab including drainage to manage effluent runoff to Moore's Creek
 - Preparation for potential electric vehicle charging (depending on level charging)
- Security
 - Lighting
 - Gates
 - Fencing
 - Surveillance Cameras upgrade
- Strategy—go as far with the improvements as possible while staying within intent of grants

Accomplish Improvements in 3 phases

- Current grants insufficient to do all improvements
- Use grants to get started (Phase 1)
- Pursue additional funding for Phases 2 and 3.
 - Phase 2 breakup into pursue "sub phases"
 - May be more successful with grants if broken out
 - Sub-phases can be stand alone



Three Facility Grants: Inadequate for Intended Projects


- Engaged Wiley | Wilson to determine the cost of implementing the grants as well as identify and cost other needs
 - Determined grants 42021-12 ("12") and 42021-14 ("14") insufficient to carry out entire projects as scoped; grant 42021-13 close to needed funding.
 - Might be able to use grants 12 and 14 to *preparatory work* for the indicated projects and secure completion funding later.



Concept Master Plan: All Phases






Break Improvements into 3 Phases

Phase	Budget	Total Phase
Phase 1 : Preparatory work/ADA improvements		\$280,000
Phase 2: Site improvements		
2A—Lots C/B Security Prep	\$200,000	
2B—Entry Gates, Fencing	\$230,000	
2C—A2 Pavement/Striping	\$160,000	
Total Phase 2		\$590,000
Phase 3: Security Cameras		\$180,000
Totals		\$1,050,000*

- Does not match prior total due to shuffling of improvements among different phases.
- Note: Phases can be pursued in different sequence and as standalone projects.


Improvement	Cost	Grant	Jaunt*
B/C Gate Prep	\$130,000	\$117,000	\$13,000
A1 ADA and gate prep	\$60,000	\$55,000	\$5,000
A2 Drainage Improvement	\$90,000	\$75,000	\$15,000
Totals	\$280,000	\$247,000	\$33,000

Estimate 41 weeks to accomplish; if start October 1, finish summer 2024.




Concept Master Plan: Phase 2
